To launch the competitive entrance examination into the **third year** of the Faculty of Industrial Engineering (FGI) of the University of Douala for the academic year 2016/2017.

## **THE MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION ANNOUNCES THAT:**

The competitive entrance examination for admission of **seventy (70) students** into the third year of the Faculty of Industrial Engineering of the University of Douala for the 2016/2017 academic year has been launched. Each department will be open to ten (10) students:

- Industrial Construction Technology;
- Hygiene and Industrial Security;
- Industrial Fishery/maritime mechanic;
- Automobile Technology;
- Telecommunication and Information Technology and Communication;
- Civil Engineering;
- Automation.

The competitive entrance examination is going to take place only in the Douala University centre and concern holders of the following certificates:

- a) Scientific degrees (Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry) and students on awaited result may apply;
- b) Diplomas of engineer of works ;
- c) Degrees in technology;
- d) All equivalence diplomas recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education.

The candidates for the competitive entrance examination into the third year must not be more than **thirty two (32) years on** the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 1<sup>st</sup> 2016.

The written examination consists of a main trade paper (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Technology). **There will be no oral exams.**

All complete application files must be deposited at the admissions office of the Faculty of Industrial Engineering (FGI) or at the University of Douala no later than **Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2016** and must include the following documents:

An individual registration form to be completed online at [www.fgi-ud.org](http://www.fgi-ud.org). The completed form shall be printed accompanied by a 1 000 francs fiscal stamp and be signed by the candidate;

1. A certified true photocopy of birth certificate not older than three months;
2. A certified true photocopy of required certificate;
3. A Certified true photocopies of level one, two and three transcripts;

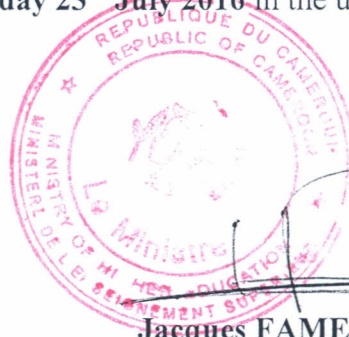
4. A certified true photocopy of “probatoire” or GCE O/L and GCE A/L or “baccalauréat” certificate or slip as the case may be;
5. A medical certificate not older than three (3) months issued by a state medical practitioner testifying that the candidate is fit for higher education;
6. Four (4) recent passport size photographs of the candidate with names written behind;

7. The registration fees for the entrance examination is **Thirty Thousand (30 000) Francs CFA** payable at the **UBA bank Account n° 0 100 500 000 287** of the University of Douala *or through the services of Express Union to the same account in towns where UBA is not present;* against a bank receipt which is obligatory included in candidates’ file of dossiers. **The registration fee is not reimbursable.** It is destined to cover charges generated as the result of the organisation of the entrance examination.

8. An A4 format self-addressed envelope bearing a 400 francs CFA postal stamp with candidate’s address on it.

Only candidates who deposit complete application files will be authorised to write, after a proof of a national identity card duely presented to the invigilator before entering the examination hall.

The written examination will take place on **Saturday 23<sup>th</sup> July 2016** in the unique centre indicated above **at 8 am.**
